Researchers, affiliation, independence








On research organization:

Evidence that research is primary goal, no commercial interests, no conflicts of interests

Potential examples: Work contracts, financial commitments, statutes, laws, membership proof, explanations of contractual relations with commercial entities



Funding






Potential examples: Financial/funding commitments, signed letters





Documentation of source, amount, duration of funding

Potential examples: Financial/funding commitments, signed letters



Research topic: VLOP, systemic risk








Description of VLOP and systemic risk(s)/risk mitigation studied + data requested



Necessity and proportionality




Proof of considering rights/legitimate interests of users and companies

Potential examples: Data management plan, data protection impact assessment



Data protection

Germany: DSC coordinating with data protection authorities






Proof of (further) GDPR compliance regarding the entire cycle of data use

Potential examples: Data management plan, data protection impact assessment, explanations regarding data retention/data deletion/international data transfers, certificates on data protection knowledge



Data security, confidentiality






Considerations of trade secrets, (physical) data security

Potential examples: Policies on information security, activity logging/access restrictions, encryption, data deletion and/or against hacking; explanations of physical infrastructure; ISO standards



Publication





Commitment to publication of research results free of charge




